

I request that my comments are minuted.

Six parishioners called for a Parish Meeting which took place last Sunday. Various views were discussed, but overall there was a deep dissatisfaction expressed with the way the Parish Council conducts their affairs.

Specifically, the lack of recording in the minutes, a refusal to engage with the community, a lack of robust debate and listening to the findings of your own Working Party. There were also many concerns expressed over planning issues.

This meeting culminated in a vote of no confidence in the way the Parish Council conducts its affairs – by a vote of 72 to 1.

Unfortunately, you have not learned the lessons of your handling of the Recreation Ground and have appeared to allowed the installation of CCTV on the Pavilion without public consultation and privacy impact assessment demanded by the guidelines.

This is now your time and opportunity to learn lessons, to put these issues right and represent your community.
