- 1. A resident complained at the grass condition after the recent cut by StreetScene. They have been asked to revisit in drier conditions.
- 2. Mr. Elworthy of Ashfield has gained permission from CDE to replace a fence and a small gate on the Recreation Ground. The Clerk is checking with CDE re regulations on the use of gates
- 3. Council's request for two new salt bins has been successful. These will now be purchased and put in place by Highways.
- 4. The Environment Agency are carrying out a review, following the recent flash floods. No serious problems were report in our Parish.
- 5. New lamps have now been fitted in the Car Park. Residents are happy with the result.
- 6. Fords have had ongoing difficulties but have finally repaired the flushing mechanism in the Gent's toilets.
- 7. Two members of the public reported vandalism at the grave of their relative in All Saints Churchyard. The Clerk has spoken to the Churchrepresentatives about this and has sent a letter of regret to the people concerned.
- 8. Airband plan to fit a pole outside the Arena. The Clerk has asked CDE if they know about this and may want to site it differently.
