Clerk's Notes – August & September 2023

- 1. The Environment Agency has provided details about the different responsibilities for weed clearance or landfall along the Brook. They will clear the unregistered parts on either side of the main road, under their permissive powers. Residents are responsible for both sides of the Brook.
- 2. Electricity Supply for toilets and carpark lights: We have one year to go on our existing three- year contract. We currently pay £22.00 pm via EDF. We can lock in to a new contract with British Gas, to run from 2024 now, if we want clarity on forthcoming costs. The offer is £28.00 per month, fixed for two years (an increase of around £72.00 p.a.). Or if Councillors think prices may come down, we can wait to renew in 2024.
- 3. Hedge Cutting on Recreation Ground. This cost £600.00 and took place on 8th September with all necessary H&S precautions and notices.
- 4. Street Sign: The "High Street" street sign beside All Saints Church has been knocked down. I have reported it to EDDC.
