

Report re Village Hall – Louis Allan

New taps have been fitted in the VH with the aim of saving water and thus reducing expenditure. In the same vein the heating is now controlled by a push button selector which will shut down the boiler after a set time. This will overcome the problem of users forgetting to turn down the heating when quitting the hall.

The range in the hall kitchen has been condemned and capped after two faults were identified during a service. A replacement has been arranged which should be connected and commissioned this week. The damaged refrigerator has also been replaced by a more economic model which also incorporate a small freezer.

The new (second hand) lightweight chairs for the hall are in the final stages of checking, cleaning and refurbishment.

There will be a general tidy up of the VH grounds on Saturday 27 April to which villagers will be invited.
