Stay alert to uneven ground & other users of the trail

*There are rubbing Posts along the route, so take pencils or crayons & paper
(available from the Community Shop)*

Follow the Trail from Tidwell Lane by the Pound, first right and on to the Farmhouse. There is a beautiful view over the Village near the top of the pass, where you can take a rest.

When out in the countryside:

- you are going into places where our wildlife lives
- most can be easily scared if anything strange is either in or near their home
- they are particularly good at hiding too, so can be difficult to spot.

Things to remember because you are a stranger in their territory.

- move slowly & quietly
- look & listen very carefully
- ask yourself "what made that movement or noise" ?
- always stay alert- you might spot something unexpected.
